Watch Movies For Free!

- Why would a website offer free movies?
 - They show ads and make \$ from the ad revenue
 - The website wants to entice you there to install malware, etc
 - In YouTube, enter “How to watch movies for free” and you will get videos that lead you to dubious sites
 - If in doubt, enter the website URL into Google search

 - Someone has a big heart and want to provide a good deed to mankind
 - A philanthropist movie buff?

 - YouTube is owned by Google

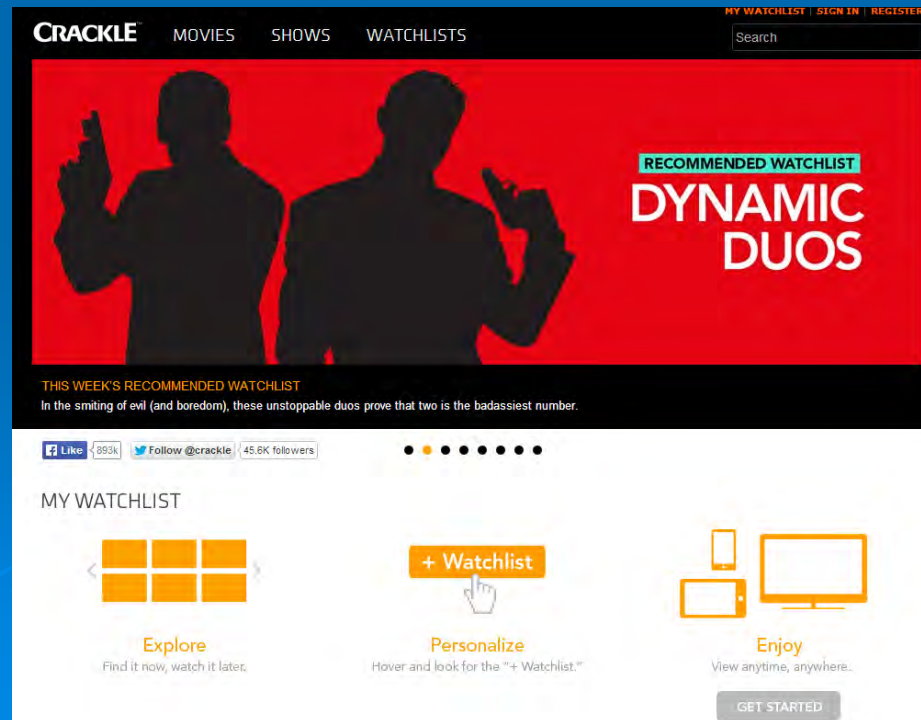



- Enter: watch “the sting”
- Make sure “Web of Trust” (WOT) is installed in your browser so you know the link your are being taken to is malware free.



WOT is red (bad... don't click!)

WOT is green (ok to click!)

Watch Movies (not) For Free!

- Benefits for paying monthly fee:
 - Larger selection of recent content
 - None or minimal Ads
 - With major sites, no concern about clicking a malware infected link.

Hacker Proof Your PC!

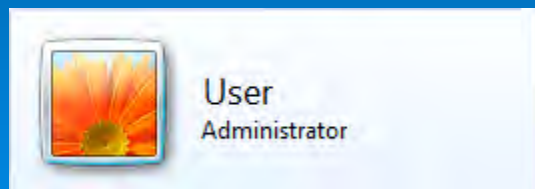
- Don't operate your PC as the "Administrator"
 - Most computers for purchase are set up to log in as the Administrator.
 - Most people don't know how to set up their computers any other way.
 - Benefit of logging in as a "Standard" user (Windows 7 or 8) or "Limited" user (Windows XP)
 - You cannot install new software or make system changes as a Standard user
 - A hacker who takes over your PC can't install malicious software on your PC when you are logged in as a Standard user, because they need to log in as administrator.
 - You can lend your computer out to someone
 - with less concern they will mess around with your settings or inadvertently install junk / malicious software

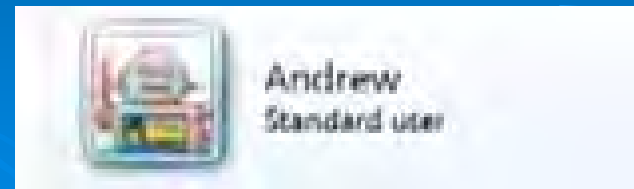
- How do you know if you are logged in as an “Administrator” or a “Standard” user?
 - Control Panel > User Accounts And Family Safety > User Accounts



- Click User accounts and you will get:

Change Windows 7 Administrator to Standard Account

- Let's say you have been using the original Administrator account that came with your PC... so to protect your PC you now want to:
 - Create a new Administrator account
 - Make sure to give it a password... a simple easy to remember password is fine
 - Change your original Administrator acct to a Standard User
 - This preserves your original desktop settings, program settings, etc. You want your new Standard account to have the same settings as your original Administrator account

So...

Change Windows 7 Administrator to Standard Account

➤ Step-by-Step:

1) Create a new Administrator account

- Give it a password. Name it “Admin-xxx”

2) Change your original Administrator account to a Standard User

- Keep the same name (usually “User”) you had as Administrator

- Give it a password if multiple users will use PC
- Keep the same name, because if you change account name, then your existing “My Documents” parent folder name will not match your new user name:

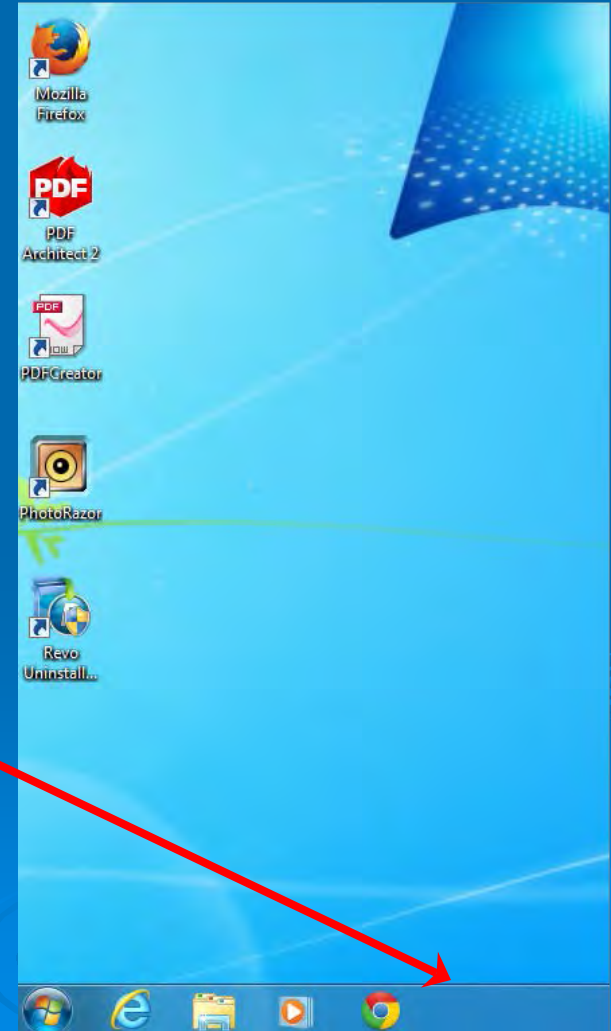


Change Windows 7 Administrator to Standard Account

Change Windows 7 Administrator to Standard Acct

➤ Create a new Administrator account

- Control Panel > User accounts and family safety > User accounts > Add or remove user account > Create a new account > **1** Give it a name “Admin-xxx” such as Admin-Kimbo > **2** Click “Administrator” button

Name the account and choose an account type

This name will appear on the Welcome screen and on the Start menu.

Standard user
Standard account users can use most software and change system settings that do not affect other users or the security of the computer.

2 Administrator
Administrators have complete access to the computer and can make any desired changes. Based on notification settings, administrators may be asked to provide their password or confirmation before making changes that affect other users.

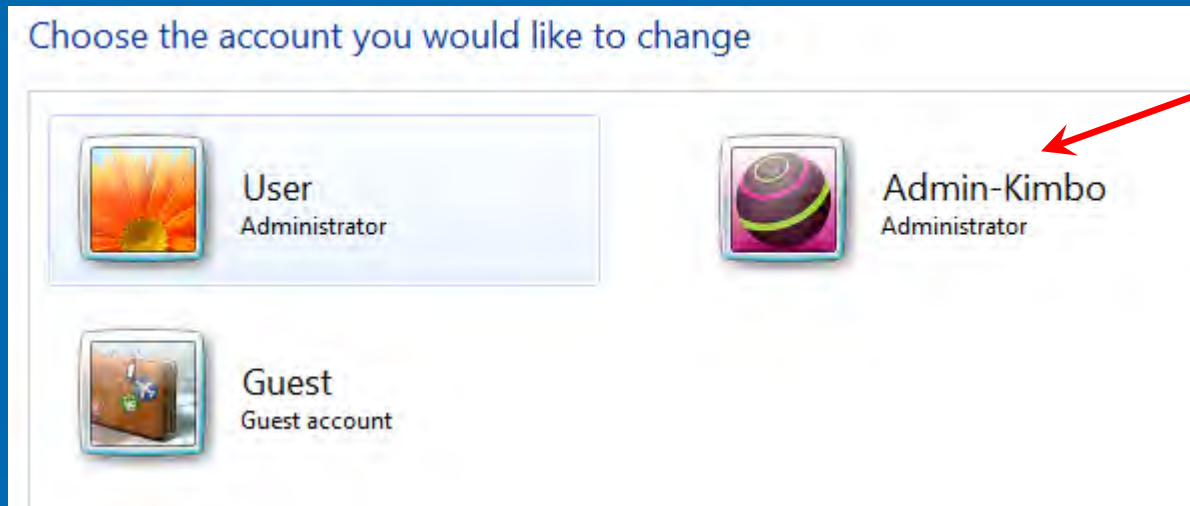
We recommend that you protect every account with a strong password.

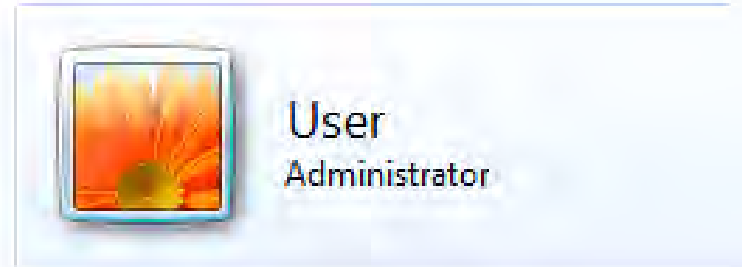

- Now when you boot your PC, you get two icons to choose how to log in
 - The new Standard Account without password
 - You can create a password for Standard account if you wish
 - The Administrator account with password
