> What is an eBook?

- An eBook (Electronic Book) is a book-length publication in digital form, consisting of text and images.
- Most all recent hard cover books have an eBook equivalent.
 Some eBooks will not have an
 - equivalent hard cover book.

eBook... viewed on Amazon Kindle eBook reader



> How do you read an eBook?

- On a dedicated eBook reader such as Amazon Kindle or Barnes & Noble Nook
- Tablet pc
- Smartphone
- Your home computer







What special features do eBook readers have?

- Typically they have displays that are very easy on the eyes to read. E-ink (used on B/W readers) can be read in direct sunlight and is closest to a real book. E-ink readers have very long battery life (typically weeks).
- Most readers today can hold thousands of eBooks.
- Allow you to adjust the text size to YOUI liking.
- You don't need to keep your entire library on the reader.
 Most books can stay in the cloud and only be downloaded to the device as needed.
- > How do you turn pages on an eBook reader?
 - Most readers allow you to swipe to the next page. Early readers typically used a button.

- Adjustable text size (8 sizes)

Book Intro – Where to Get eBooks Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Google Playstore, and Apple iTunes are major sources.

- Amazon books need to be read on a Kindle reader or with the Amazon app. Barnes & Noble Nook books need to be read on a Nook or with the Nook app.
- When purchased from Amazon or Barnes & Noble, a copy of your eBook exists backed up in the cloud.
- Readers have wireless capability that allow you to order directly from the parent company.

Most libraries allow you to borrow eBooks online.

 You don't have to return eBooks to your library... or worry about late fines, as typically the books expire after a certain date.


How Much do eBooks Cost?

- There are a variety of free and low cost eBooks available. However, you will pay more for major releases and best-sellers.

Clicking Links on Web Pages

Click the "News" link and the link will open in either:


- 1) A new web browser window

Open link in new tab Open link in new window Open link in incognito window Save link as... Copy link address




Opening Links onto a new Tab

1) Rt Click the contextual menu, or:


2) Click down on the mouse scroll wheel.






Closing Web PageTabs
